The oral judgment of the court was delivered by  
Allen, P:

Having heard the appeal, the court sees no error of law in the learned judge's exercise of his discretion not to grant bail. We find that he took into account all of the relevant principles. We also find that the trial is imminent and by the time the appellant is tried, he will have been in custody 21 months which we find not to be unreasonable in the circumstances of The Bahamas.

In all of the circumstances, we uphold the learned judge's decision to deny bail. Bail therefore is denied.
