2 Crane-Scott, JA:

3 This matter is not going to be heard today because
4 there are a few complications. The first complication relates
5 to Mr. Hanna, who has told us that he got the papers from the
6 Crown yesterday. He has also hired Mr. Cargill, who
7 apparently is not well and therefore is not in court today.

8 As for Mr. Brennen, Mr. Brennen wants to be

11 hired to continue the matter when this matter comes on before
12 us again. Mr. Brennen also needs to file a Form 2 at the
13 Court of Appeal.

16 Hopefully, Mr. Cargill will be better by then and
17 will have filed written submissions to support Mr. Hanna's
18 extension of time application.

19 As for Mr. Brennen, he will try to get a telephone
20 call as soon as possible to his family and get an attorney-at-
21 law in place at his expense and have written submissions
22 filed. In the meantime, Mr. Brennen has to file his Form 2.
