1 The oral judgment of the court was delivered by
2 Blackman, P (Ag):

3 The court is of the view that this is a very small
4 discrete point. Given what counsel for the appellant has said
5 in terms of the quantity, we think the appropriate thing is to
6 set aside the sentence and remit the matter back to Magistrate
7 Court No. 2, Freeport, Grand Bahama for the consideration of
8 the appropriate sentence.

9 As we laid down in Andrew Davis and
10 Anthony Armbrister, the matter of sentencing is for the court
11 who hears the matter, as it is fully seized of all the facts.

12 The appeal is allowed and is therefore remitted to
13 the court below for appropriate sentencing.
