2 Crane-Scott, JA:

3           Based on our understanding of this matter, the  
4 intended appellant wishes no longer to have the Office of the  
5 Public Defender assigned to his matter nor does he want anyone  
6 within that office to deal with the matter. Therefore, we  
7 accede to the application of counsel, Ms Cadet, to withdraw  
8 from representation of the intended appellant.

9           We, therefore, ask the Registrar to assign a Crown  
10 brief to a willing person on her list, and we will appoint  
11 a mention day when that person will come to indicate whether  
12 they accept the brief or not.

13           We adjourn this matter to Thursday, 6th June, 2019,  
14 for mention. On that day, the lawyer that the Registrar will  
15 select should come to court to indicate whether they will  
16 accept the brief to represent the intended appellant.
