1 The oral judgment of the court was delivered by

2 Allen, P:

3 Having heard the submissions on behalf of the
4 appellant and having read and considered the evidence, and
5 having looked at the submissions of the respondent, we find no
6 merit in any of the three grounds of appeal commended to us.
7 We are of the view that the magistrate heard and saw the
8 witnesses as they gave their evidence and was competent to
9 determine whom she believed, and found the appellant guilty.

10 In those circumstances, we are loathed to interfere
11 with her findings of fact in the absence of any errors of law
12 committed by her. We therefore dismiss the appeal and affirm
13 the convictions and sentences of the learned magistrate.

14 The appellant is committed to prison to serve his
15 sentences with effect from today.
