6 security in a sum not exceeding \$2,861.00 for the due
7 prosecution of the appeal and the payment of all such costs as
8 may become payable by the applicant in the event of him not
9 obtaining an order granting him final leave to appeal or of
10 the appeal being dismissed for non-prosecution or of the
11 Judicial Committee ordering the applicant to pay the costs of
12 the appeal; and that within 90 days from the date hereof, the
13 applicant shall take the necessary steps for the purpose of
14 procuring the preparation of the record and the dispatch
15 thereof to England.
