1 The oral judgment of the court was delivered by

2 Isaacs, JA:

3 We had during the course of the hearing faintly made
4 the suggestion that we were going to make contact with the
5 judge in the matter to ascertain from him whether he had any
6 record of what transpired in chambers, whether the clerk or
7 himself took notes, since quite a bit of what was said in the
8 court before us related to whatever may have gone on in
9 chambers.

10 In the circumstances, we are going to make a request
11 of the judge that he provide us with either his recollection
12 or his records or that of his clerk to assist us in
13 determining what transpired in chambers.

14 Once his response is received, it will be shared
15 with counsel, and counsel will be given the opportunity to
16 make such representations or submissions as they may wish to
17 make pertaining thereto.

18 This means, therefore, that our reserved decision is
19 going to be delayed pending receipt of the judge's response.
