RE-ISSUE OF PRACTICE DIRECTION NO. 2 OF 1996

(BUNDLES OF AUTHORITIES)

“Counsel and Attorneys generally observe the practice of submitting bundles of authorities for use of the judges in appeals and applications to be heard in the Court of Appeal.

It facilitates reference to such authorities during the course of argument, to have the bundles indexed and tabbed, and promotes efficiency in presentation of submission at bar.

The practice of submitting bundles of authorities and indexing and tabbing them, which is already followed by a number of counsel and attorneys, is hereby made compulsory in all cases”.

The Practice Direction quoted above intends that both indexing and tabbing must be done. Tabbing alone is not sufficient.
